Data analysis and interpretation have now taken centre stage with the advent of the digital age. This is a gesture for successful research in today's global world to analyze complex data. The interpretation of data assigns a meaning to the information analyzed and determines its implications. Hence, it needs to be done properly. Data analysis tends to be extremely subjective. That is to say, the nature and goal of interpretation will vary from one research to another. Disparate methods will lead to duplicated efforts. In this part a main look at the two main methods of interpretation of data with a qualitative and a quantitative analysis is needed. The results of research for policy

planning, decision-making and implementation processes and its features have changed over time. The issue has gained prominence in recent decades. Extensive academic output, using a diversity of approaches and analytical frameworks, has sought to systematize knowledge transfer .The application of knowledge transfer ideas to educational policy and systems, research does generate many interesting contributions. E-learning has redefined strategies and concepts of teaching that have enabled the teaching community to perform better.
