"Reminiscence of Non- Cooperation Movement in Andhra"

The Department of History, Archaeology and Culture has organised one day Webinar, on Reminiscence of Non-Cooperation Movement in Andhra. On Thursday 02-09-2021 at 10.30 AM, via online, Google meet app. Prof. Tummala Ramakrishna garu, Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, Dravidian University was the Chief Guest of the Webinar. Prof. Ch. A. Rajendra Prasad, Rector, and Dr. A. K. Venugopal Reddy, Registrar (I/C), were the guests of honour. Prof. D. Ananda Naidu SVU-Tirupati, Prof. K. Mallikarjuna Reddy, SKD-Ananthpur, Prof. G. J. Sudhakar, C.P.R.I.I.R. Chennai, and Prof. Sambasiva Reddy of YVU-Kadapa participated as Resource persons. Dr. Mercy Rathna Rani Head of the department welcomed the guests to the Webinar. Prof. Aravind Kumar convenor of the Webinar explained significance of the theme. Hon'ble V.C. Sir, highlighted the important events of Non-Cooperation movement in Andhra, Swadeshi movement, the establishment of Jatiyakalashala, etc.., and stressed the role of nationalist poets and how they enlightened the masses and inspired them through their nationalistic poetry. Prof. Rajendra Prasad explained the significance of Non-Cooperation movement and its Socio, Economic and political impact. Dr. A.K.
